

COVID travel guide for Belgium

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter Belgium you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have completed a passenger locator form 	<p>To be considered 'fully vaccinated', the Belgian government requires that your final dose was given no more than 270 days before your time of entry.</p> <p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>This form can be completed here.</p>
Upon arrival, be prepared to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your NHS COVID Pass for Travel 	We recommend having evidence of your vaccination record or test result in both digital and printed format.
While in Belgium you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Need to wear a face covering on public transport 	Failure to wear a mask may incur a fine.
