

COVID travel guide for Bulgaria

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter Bulgaria you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>To be considered 'fully vaccinated', the Bulgarian government requires that you have received your final dose of the vaccine more than 14 days before the date of travel.</p> <p>This must be a PCR test, taken no more than 72 hours before your time of arrival or a lateral flow test taken no more than 48 hours prior to your arrival; please use a private testing provider. More information can be found here.</p> <p>More information on these requirements can be found here.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your NHS COVID Pass for Travel OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your negative COVID test result 	<p>We recommend having evidence of your vaccination record or test result in both digital and printed format.</p>
While in Bulgaria it is recommended that you:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear a face covering on public transport and in crowded areas 	<p>Although no longer mandatory, the Bulgarian authorities encourage face coverings to be worn.</p>
