

COVID travel guide for Costa Rica

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<p>Costa Rica has no specific entry rules in response to COVID. To join your Exodus trip you will, however, need to comply with our COVID-Clear requirement.</p> <p>Prior to departure, you will need to show:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 72 hours before arrival. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Proof of recovery from COVID 	<p>Further information on our COVID-Clear policy and how to demonstrate this to us can be found here.</p> <p>We will contact you prior to your trip by email with guidance on how to submit this information to us.</p>
<p>Before departure you will need to:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete an advanced epidemiological information form with the Costa Rican authorities 	<p>This is done by going here.</p> <p>The online form will ask you to confirm if you have been fully vaccinated or have travel insurance in place that will cover accommodation and medical costs should you become infected with COVID while in Costa Rica.</p> <p>This insurance is not required by the Costa Rican authorities if you are fully vaccinated, but Exodus require all travellers to have adequate and valid travel insurance. We strongly recommend your policy provides cover for claims arising from a COVID infection. Information on the Exodus travel insurance policy, which provides this cover, can be found here.</p> <p>Upon completion of the form, you will be issued with a QR code. Please save a copy of this in either digital or printed format.</p>
<p>Upon arrival you will:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show the QR code from your advanced epidemiological information form If you are not fully vaccinated, that you have travel insurance in place to cover accommodation and medical costs arising from a COVID infection 	<p>Please have this saved on your mobile device or in printed format prior to travel.</p> <p>If you are not fully vaccinated and need assistance regarding travel insurance, please contact our Customer Operations Team.</p>

IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING TO COSTA RICA VIA THE UNITED STATES	
<p>You will need to show:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID <p>AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID test no more than 72 hours before travel. 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted; you must have completed your course of vaccination at least 14 days before departure.</p> <p>This can be a PCR or lateral flow test, taken no more than 72 hours before departure.</p> <p>If you are not fully vaccinated, you can travel via the US, but your test must be taken no more than 24 hours before departure.</p> <p>For your return journey, a COVID test can be taken in Costa Rica towards the end of your trip. This will be arranged by our local team.</p> <p>More information on this requirement can be found here.</p>

10 days	<input type="checkbox"/> Book your COVID test(s) to be taken after your return home – the type of test(s) will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here . Information on private testing providers can be found here . <input type="checkbox"/> If you are travelling via the US, book your COVID test
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are fully vaccinated and travelling via the US, take your COVID test <input type="checkbox"/> Obtain your NHS COVID Pass for Travel. You will need this when you complete your Return to UK Passenger Locator Form.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete the online registration form with Costa Rican authorities and save/print the resultant QR code
24 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are not fully vaccinated and travelling via the US, take your COVID test
	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation

BEFORE YOU RETURN HOME CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING TO THE UK	
<i>Time before travel</i>	
72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If applicable, take your return to UK test – this will depend on your vaccination status and in which part of the UK you reside. For full information on this please check here .
48 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> Complete your UK arrivals Passenger Locator Form (link here) <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure you have downloaded/printed copies of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and completed Passenger Locator Form. Guidance on how to obtain your COVID Pass can be found here
	<input type="checkbox"/> Check in online and expect to supply copies of entry documentation
24 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are returning to the UK via the US, take your COVID test
On departure	<input type="checkbox"/> Show copies of your NHS COVID Pass and Passenger Locator Form to airline staff at check-in/at the gate
Return home	<input type="checkbox"/> Take your COVID test(s) – either day 2 only or day 2 and day 8 (depending upon your vaccination status/country of residence)
