

## **COVID** travel guide for Azores

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter the Azores you will need to show:	
<ul> <li>That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> <li>OR</li> <li>That you have received a negative COVID-19 test carried out by a healthcare professional</li> </ul>	The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a> .  To be considered 'fully vaccinated', the Portuguese government requires that you have received your final dose of the vaccine at least 14 days and no more than 270 days before the date of arrival.  This must be a PCR test, taken no more than 72 hours before boarding or a lateral flow test within 24 hours of boarding. Please use a private testing provider and note that self-administered tests are not accepted. More information can be found
