

COVID travel guide for Ecuador (including the Galapagos Islands)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To take part in an Exodus trip in Ecuador you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 	<p>To be 'fully vaccinated' you must have completed the full course of vaccination at least 14 days before the date of your departure.</p> <p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For guidance on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>It is possible to enter Ecuador if you are not fully vaccinated, by providing evidence of a negative COVID test prior to travel. There are, however, restrictions on what you are able to do while in Ecuador if you are not fully vaccinated. We are therefore only able to accept individuals who are fully vaccinated on Exodus trips in Ecuador.</p>
To enter the Galapagos Islands:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 	As above, the NHS COVID Pass for travel is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status.
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete a Health Declaration Form 	<p>The form can be accessed here. You will need to print this off and can expect to be asked to show the completed form when you board your flight.</p> <p>You will be asked to provide addresses for where you will stay for 21 days after arrival. You can enter the details for your first night's accommodation; this is displayed on your final joining instructions (FJIs), which will be sent to you approximately three weeks before travel.</p> <p>Please also have a copy of your FJIs with you when you travel, should these be required by airline staff/immigration officials to confirm your overall travel plans while in Ecuador, and to show evidence of your return flights. This also applies when arriving in the Galapagos Islands.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show evidence of your vaccination status Show your completed Health Declaration Form 	<p>Please ensure you have the correct evidence with you before you depart.</p> <p>If you are displaying COVID symptoms on arrival, you may be evaluated by a clinician at the airport, before going through immigration. These checks may also be carried out when arriving in the Galapagos Islands.</p>

IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING TO ECUADOR VIA THE UNITED STATES
You will need to show:

- That you are fully vaccinated against COVID

The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted; you must have completed your course of vaccination at least 14 days before departure.

Please note, if you are not fully vaccinated you will not be permitted to transit via the US. More information on this is available [here](#).
