

COVID travel guide for Kazakhstan

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter Kazakhstan you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test 	<p>To be considered 'fully vaccinated', your final dose must have been administered at least 14 days before the date of travel. The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>This must be a PCR test taken no more than 72 hours before your time of arrival into Kazakhstan; please use a private testing provider.</p> <p>More information on these requirements and other processes in place for travellers arriving in Kazakhstan can be found here.</p>
Upon arrival be prepared to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your NHS COVID Pass for Travel If applicable, show your negative COVID-19 test result 	<p>We recommend having evidence of your vaccination record or test result in both digital and printed format.</p>
