

COVID travel guide for New Zealand

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter New Zealand you will need to show:	
	To be considered fully vaccinated by the New Zealand government, you must have completed a full course of vaccines no less than 14 days before entering.
That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19	The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go <u>here</u> .
	It is possible to enter New Zealand if you are not fully vaccinated, but you must meet strict exemptions <u>rules</u> , most of which do not apply to Exodus clients. If you believe you are exempt, please contact our Customer Operations team for more information.
Before arrival you will need to:	
Complete the traveller declaration and be issued a traveller pass AND	This can be completed <u>here</u> . You will need to show your traveller pass when you check-in at the airport and to customs when you arrive in New Zealand. We would recommend carry a paper and electronic copy of your pass.
Obtain a New Zealand electronic travel authority	This can be completed <u>here</u> and costs roughly £25. It takes up to 72 hours to process so we would recommend allowing plenty of time to complete it.
Upon arrival you will be asked to:	
Complete a lateral flow test	You will also be provided with a pack of tests with instructions for use. The first test must be taken the day you arrive and the second and final test on either day 5 or 6.
	You will receive an email from the Ministry of Health with instructions on how to report your result.
