

COVID travel guide for Japan

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter Japan you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test result AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have completed a health declaration form 	<p>This must be a PCR test taken within 72 hours of your flight departure time. You must use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.</p> <p>This can be completed here and can be translated into English using the drop-down menu at the top of the page. We would recommend having your Final Joining Instructions with you whilst completing it.</p>
Before arrival you will need to:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obtain a valid tourist visa AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sign a written pledge 	<p>You should have received a letter from our customer operations team about the ERFS application process.</p> <p>This will be given to you by your airline and commits you to abiding by Japan's COVID-related rules and requirements.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be prepared to show airport health staff your negative PCR test result, signed pledge and completed self-declaration form AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Install a COVID-19 tracing app 	<p>Please ensure you have the correct documents with you before you depart.</p> <p>This is available on android and iOS smartphones.</p>
