

COVID travel guide for Bhutan

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
<p>The below guidance has been based on the latest information we have received from our local partners, who are privy to official communications from the Bhutanese government which have not yet been widely announced. We are therefore confident that the requirements outlined will be confirmed shortly, but they still may be subject to change.</p>	
<p>To enter Bhutan you will need to show:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID-19 vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this, please go here.</p> <p>You must be able to provide a physical copy of your COVID pass for proof of vaccination status.</p> <p>It is possible to enter Bhutan if you are not fully vaccinated, however, you are required to self-isolate for over 24 hours after arrival.</p> <p>We are therefore only able to accept individuals who are fully vaccinated on Exodus trips in Bhutan.</p>
<p>Upon arrival you will need to:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your NHS COVID Pass for Travel Show your travel insurance includes medical cover for COVID-19 	<p>You must have evidence of your vaccination record and travel insurance in printed format.</p>
<p>While in Bhutan we recommend that you:</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear a mask in public spaces 	<p>This is advised by the Bhutanese government but is not strictly enforced.</p>
