

## **COVID** travel guide for Bolivia

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter Bolivia you will need to show:	
	To be considered 'fully vaccinated', you must be able to show that you have completed the full vaccination course at least 14 days before arrival.
<ul> <li>That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> <li>OR</li> <li>That you have received a negative COVID-19 test result</li> <li>AND</li> <li>Register your hotel address online</li> </ul>	Your <b>NHS COVID Pass for Travel</b> will be accepted as evidence for these. For guidance on how to obtain your Pass please go <u>here</u> .
	This must be a PCR test taken no more than 72 hours prior to departure, or a lateral flow test taken within 48 hours prior to departure; please use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.
	This must be done <u>here</u> and should be updated for each hotel you visit. Failure to comply may result in fines on leaving Bolivia.
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul> <li>Show evidence of your COVID vaccination record</li> <li>OR</li> <li>If applicable, show evidence of your negative COVID test result</li> </ul>	Please ensure you have your documents with you before you depart and readily available throughout your journey. If you are using you NHS COVID Pass for Travel, please make sure this is accessible to you in both digital and paper formats on entry to Bolivia.

72 hours	□ If applicable, take your PCR test and obtain your result	
48 hours	□ If applicable, take your lateral flow test and obtain your result	
24 hours	Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation
