

COVID travel guide for India

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter India you will need to show:	
 That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 OR That you have received a negative COVID-19 test result AND That you have submitted a self-declaration form 	Evidence of a full course of vaccination must be uploaded to the relevant section of the self-declaration form, which can be found <u>here</u> . This must be a PCR test taken no more than 72 hours before travel. Evidence of your negative result must be uploaded to the relevant section of the self-declaration form, which can be found <u>here</u> . You must use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to <u>this guide</u> .
Before arrival you will need to:	
Obtain a valid tourist visa	Information on visa applications can be found <u>here</u> . Please note that the application can take up to 2 weeks to process.
Upon arrival you will:	
 Be required to undergo thermal screening by health officials AND Be prepared to show airport health staff your completed self-declaration form, vaccination certificate or negative PCR result AND Be prepared to undergo random COVID-19 testing 	Please ensure you have the correct documents with you before you depart.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE CHECKLIST:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
Time before departure	
14 days	 Reconfirm your destination entry requirements If you have not already done so, apply for a tourist visa
10 days	 If not fully vaccinated, book your COVID test for entry into India If fully vaccinated, complete your self-declaration form
72 hours	□ If not fully vaccinated, take your PCR test for entry into India. Upon receipt of the result, complete your self-declaration form
48 hours	Check in online & expect to supply copies of entry documentation
