

## **COVID** travel guide for South Korea

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter South Korea, you will need to:	
Take a COVID test upon arrival and return a negative result	This applies irrespective of your individual vaccination status.
	The test can be booked in advance and taken at the airport. After taking the test, you will be able to travel to your start hotel, where you will be required to remain in your room until your result is processed. This usually takes around four hours.

Before arrival you can choose to:	
Book your arrival PCR test	This can be booked by going <u>here</u> .
	You will be required to enter your arrival details, including flight information. We have found that the online form can be unreliable; if you are not able to register online you can take the test on arrival at the airport by going to the COVID Testing Centre.
	The test costs approximately £50. This must be paid either by credit card or in Korean Won.
	After taking the test you can proceed to your start hotel, where you will need to self-isolate in your room until you receive your result. This usually takes around four hours.

While in South Korea you will:	
Be required to wear a face covering while indoors and on public transport	Failure to adhere to this can result in a fine of approximately £62.
