

COVID travel guide for India

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter India you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have received a negative COVID-19 test result AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have submitted a self-declaration form 	<p>Evidence of a full course of vaccination must be uploaded to the relevant section of the self-declaration form, which can be found here.</p> <p>This must be a PCR test taken no more than 72 hours before travel. Evidence of your negative result must be uploaded to the relevant section of the self-declaration form, which can be found here.</p> <p>You must use a private testing provider. For more details on testing and private providers, please refer to this guide.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be required to undergo thermal screening by health officials AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be prepared to show airport health staff your completed self-declaration form, vaccination certificate or negative PCR result AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be prepared to undergo random COVID-19 testing 	<p>Please ensure you have the correct documents with you before you depart.</p>

72 hours	<input type="checkbox"/> If not fully vaccinated, take your PCR test for entry into India. Upon receipt of the result, complete your self-declaration form
