

## COVID travel guide for Ecuador (including the Galapagos Islands)

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

| FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK   |  |

| <p>There are no specific entry requirements for Ecuador in relation to COVID. All travellers will therefore need to fulfil Exodus' COVID-Clear policy. Full details on this can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>Please note that the below guide is for entry into this country only; if your trip includes travel to another country there may be additional or different requirements. Please refer to the relevant country guide for more details.</p> <p><b>Prior to your trip, you will need to either:</b></p> |  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be fully vaccinated against COVID</li> </ul> <p><b>OR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Receive a negative COVID test result before travelling</li> </ul>  | <p>The total number of doses must have been given, as required by the vaccine manufacturer (in most cases this is two doses), with the last dose having been administered no less than two weeks prior to travel.</p> <p>Please obtain a copy of your NHS COVID Pass for Travel and have this readily available during your trip. For guidance on how to obtain this, please go <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>If you are not fully vaccinated, please take a COVID test no more than 72 hours before departure. This can be either a PCR or lateral flow test.</p> <p>This must be a private test; information on COVID testing and private providers can be found <a href="#">here</a>.</p> <p>Checks may be made by our UK based team prior to travel, or during your trip by your tour leader. If you are unable to provide proof when requested on the trip, you will need to take a COVID test locally, at your own expense.</p> |
| <p><b>Before arrival you will need to:</b></p>   |  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete a Health Declaration Form</li> </ul>   | <p>The form can be accessed <a href="#">here</a>. You will need to print this off and can expect to be asked to show the completed form when you board your flight.</p> <p>You will be asked to provide addresses for where you will stay for 21 days after arrival. You can enter the details for your first night's accommodation; this is displayed on your final joining instructions (FJIs), which will be sent to you approximately three weeks before travel.</p> <p>Please also have a copy of your FJIs with you when you travel, should these be required by airline staff/immigration officials to confirm your overall travel plans while in Ecuador, and to show evidence of your return flights. This also applies when arriving in the Galapagos Islands.</p>   |
| <p><b>Upon arrival you will:</b></p>   |  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Show your completed Health Declaration Form</li> </ul>  | <p>If you are displaying COVID symptoms on arrival, you may be evaluated by a clinician at the airport, before going through immigration. These checks may also be carried out when arriving in the Galapagos Islands.</p>   |

**IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING TO ECUADOR VIA THE UNITED STATES**
**You will need to show:**

- That you are fully vaccinated against COVID

The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted; you must have completed your course of vaccination at least 14 days before departure.
