

COVID travel guide for Nepal

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK	
To enter the country you will need to show:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you are fully vaccinated against COVID OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Evidence of a negative COVID test AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> That you have adequate travel insurance in place for the duration of your time in Nepal 	<p>The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your vaccination status. For more information on how to obtain this please go here.</p> <p>This must be a PCR test, taken within 72 hours of your departure to Nepal. If your journey involves a flight connection, it must be within 72 hours of your first flight.</p>
Upon arrival you will:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be asked to show evidence that you have fulfilled the entry requirements AND <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be asked for proof of your initial hotel booking 	<p>This may include your NHS COVID Pass for Travel, negative test result and/or travel insurance. Please have all your documents with you when you travel.</p> <p>This is the start hotel listed on your Final Joining Instructions.</p>
