This exciting journey includes a comprehensive three-day 4WD adventure that reveals Bolivia's eye-catching multi-colored lagoons, cacti islands, and spouting geysers. In stark contrast to the incredible nature, visit the vibrant cities of Sucre, Potosi, and La Paz whose history and culture run deep with the Incas and the Spanish Conquistadores. To finish your adventure wind down with a night in an eco-lodge on the Isla del Sol overlooking the deep, tranquil waters of Lake Titicaca - surrounded by snow-capped peaks of the Cordillera Real.

O CLASSIC DOLOMITES

RCGS | Italy

The village of Villabassa – close to the Austrian border and sandwiched between the spectacular, jagged limestone peaks – is the perfect base for this Dolomites walking week. From here the group enjoys an excellent choice of routes with the opportunity to relax in comfort at the end of a day's walking.

The itinerary ventures into the Fanes-Sennes and Dolomiti di Sesto National Parks for magnificent views of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo. Along the way the group will also visit numerous open-air museums, reflecting the status of these imposing mountains as the frontline of the fighting between Italy and the Austro-Hungarian Empire in WWI.

RCGS | Peru

A spectacular journey through Peru's varied landscape encompassing coastal desert, snow-capped Andean peaks, the high altiplano, and lush cloud forest. The most famous sites are all visited including the mysterious Nazca Lines, awe-inspiring Machu Picchu in its incredible mountaintop setting, Lake Titicaca, where the night is spent in an island homestay, and the remarkable 9,800 ft/3000 m deep Colca Canyon. On the way, the group will encounter traditional culture, condors, llamas, and a warm welcome from the Peruvian people.

O ANNAPURNA SANCTUARY PHOTOGPRAPHY TREK

RCGS | Nepal

The Annapurna Himal is a vast mountain range with several peaks above 22,000 ft/7,000 m. Part of the range forms a natural amphitheater known as the Annapurna Sanctuary, ringed by such giants as Annapurna 1, Glacier Dome, Gangapurna, Fang, and Machhapuchhare. The trek starts through forested hillsides before arriving at the Sanctuary with its panoramic views of the Annapurna. At higher altitudes, the close-up mountain views are among the finest in the world. There is a day to explore this awe-inspiring mountain arena before returning to Pokhara via a different route.


