ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

FOR CUSTOMERS TRAVELLING FROM THE UK			
To enter Japan you will need to show:			
• OR •	That you are fully vaccinated That you have received a negative COVID-19 test result	 The Japanese authorities require visitors to have received two doses and a booster to qualify as fully vaccinated. The NHS COVID Pass for Travel is accepted to demonstrate your COVID vaccination status. For guidance on how to obtain this please go <u>here</u>. This must be a PCR test taken within 72 hours of your flight departure time. You must use a private testing provider. For more

•	Complete information on the Visit Japan Web site or app	As of 28 th December 2022, the Quarantine 'Fast Track' has been discontinued, which means vaccination and test certificates do not need to be uploaded to Visit Japan Web. However, we strongly advise that you do register these on the app ahead of time, and that you also bring these documents with you in physical form.
