DAY 1

MARRAKECH

The adventure begins in Marrakech, the captivating ochre city, the still very much alive, and modern antique-like city. We have a welcome meeting in the evening, in which we gather for the first time as a group.

DAY 2

AIT BENHADDOU

With time to explore Marrakech at the end of our journey, we leave the Red City behind and head into the Atlas Mountains. Our destination for the day is the well-preserved kasbah of Ait Benhaddou. This UNESCO World Heritage site is one of the most spectacular landmarks in the Atlas and the filming location for several Hollywood movies, including Gladiator (2000). The route takes us over the Tizi n'Tichka pass, the highest in Morocco, arriving mid-afternoon. On arrival join the tour leader for an orientation tour through the kasbah and then return to our hotel for a welcome dinner.

DAY 3

DRAA VALLEY

We journey through Ouarzazate, known as the "door to the desert," once a vital trade route for African traders to Europe. Now, it hosts the Atlas Film Studios, featured in numerous Hollywood films and Game of Thrones, alongside the impressive Kasbah Taourirt, a grand fort built from rammed earth and mudbrick. Continuing south, we drive along the Draa Valley, home to over four million palm trees and bordered by ksours (fortified villages). Here, we enjoy a one and a half-hour camel trek, delving deeper into the Sahara for a night of stargazing at a simple desert camp, where the vastness of the desert becomes palpable amidst the silence and countless stars.

DAY 4

ZAGORA

We wake in the desert silence, greeted by the soft hues of dawn painting the Sahara's vast landscape. Take the opportunity to capture a few breathtaking photos and immerse yourself in the tranquil atmosphere before embarking on a return camel ride. Afterward, a short drive brings us to Zagora, where we have time to rest, refresh and unwind by the pool. In the afternoon, consider joining an optional walk into the valley, to explore this renowned desert outpost.

DAY 5

TIGHZA

We journey west through the Draa Valley to join the Ounila Valley in the High Atlas Mountains. Starting our walk from Animeter, we traverse a track with short steep inclines, passing through small villages. After about an hour and a half, we reach our gite in Tighza for an overnight stay. In the evening, we visit the village hammam, funded by Exodus clients, offering a truly authentic experience. It's a traditional hammam, providing an opportunity to interact with villagers. Please note, this isn't a spa treatment. A standard treatment is included, with additional costs for a scrubber and soap (20 Moroccan dirham or US \$2) and customary tip (20 dirham). After refreshing ourselves, we return to the gite for dinner in the mountains.



DAY 6

MARRAKECH

This morning, we depart from the gite and embark on a scenic drive over the High Atlas Mountains back to Marrakech, enjoying stunning scenery along the way. We once again cross Tizi n'Tichka before arriving in Marrakech and checking into our hotel. Later, we join our Leader for a visit to a local Argan Oil cooperative. In the evening, we explore Djemma el Fna, the vibrant central square known for its lively atmosphere and diverse entertainment options, offering a glimpse into Marrakech's rich cultural heritage.
